

SCHEDULE OF PROPOSED ADMISSION OF GUILT FINES

BY-LAW RELATING TO STREETS, PUBLIC PLACES AND PREVENTION OF NUISANCES

PROHIBITED BEHAVIOUR

Sect 2(1)(a)(i)	Intentionally block or interfere with the safe or free passage of a pedestrian or vehicle	R200
Sect 2(1)(a)(ii)	Intentionally touch or cause physical contact with another person, or his or her property, without that person's consent	R400
Sect 2(1)(b)	Approach or follow a person individually or as part of a group of two or more persons, in a manner or with conduct, words or gestures intended to or likely to influence or to cause a reasonable person to fear imminent bodily harm or damage to or loss of property or otherwise to be intimidated into giving money or other things of value	R400
Sect 2(1)(c)	Continue to beg from a person or closely follow a person after the person has given a negative response to such begging	R50
Sect 2(2)	Disobeying a peace officer or member of the Cape Town Metropolitan Police Department who directs a person to immediately cease to block, occupy or reserve a public parking space or who directs a person to immediately cease to beg stand, sit or lie in a public place	R400
Sect 2(3)(a)	Use abusive or threatening language	R200
Sect 2(3)(b)	Cause a disturbance or permit a disturbance to be caused by shouting, screaming or making any other loud or persistent noise or sound including amplified noise or sound	R500
Sect 2(3)(c)	Fight or act in a riotous or physically threatening manner	R400
Sect 2(3)(d)	Urinate or defecate, except in a public toilet	R200
Sect 2(3)(e)	Bath or wash him or herself, except in a public bath house	R50
Sect 2(3)(f)	Spit on an exposed surface	R100
Sect 2(3)(g)	Perform any sexual act	R500
Sect 2(3)(h)	Appear in the nude or expose his or hers genitalia, except in such areas which may be designated by the City as areas where nudity is permitted	R500
Sect 2(3)(i)	Consume any liquor or drugs	R500
Sect 2(3)(j)	Drunk or under the influence of drugs	R500
Sect 2(3)(k)	Solicit or importune any person for the purpose of prostitution or immorality	R500
Sect 2(3)(l)	Engage in gambling	No Admission of Guilt Fine
Sect 2(3)(m)	Start or keep a fire	R200

STREET AND DOOR-TO-DOOR COLLECTIONS

Sect 3	Collect or attempt to collect money in a public place or organise or in any way assist in the organisation of such collection, except with the City's written permission and otherwise than in accordance with such conditions as may be determined by the City, excluding door-to-door collections for which no permission is required	R50

PARKING AND RELATED SERVICES

Sect 4(1)(a)	Direct the operator or occupant of a motor vehicle to a public parking space, in exchange for money or some other thing of value or in anticipation thereof	R50
Sect 4(1)(b)	Provide a parking or related service in a public place in exchange for money or some other thing of value or in anticipation thereof	R50
Sect 4(3)	Park or leave truck or other heavy duty vehicle parking overnight in a public place in a residential area	R200

OBJECTS CAUSING AN OBSTRUCTION

Sect 5(a)	Deposit, pack, unpack or leave any goods or articles in a public place, or cause any goods or articles to be deposited, packed, unpacked or left in a public place, other than for a reasonable period during the course of the loading, off-loading or removal of such goods or articles	R200
Sect 5(b)	Obstruct pedestrian traffic on sidewalk by bringing or allowing to be brought thereon any object or vehicle	R200

TREES CAUSING AN INTERFERENCE OR OBSTRUCTION

Sect 6(2)	Fail to comply with notice ordering the owner or occupier of property to prune or remove tree or other growth which interferes with overhead wires or is a source of annoyance, danger or inconvenience to persons using a public road	R300

TREES IN STREETS

Sect 7(1)(a)	Plant a tree or shrub in a public road or cut it down or remove it without written permission	R300
Sect 7(1)(b)	Climb, break or damage a tree growing in a public road	R300
Sect 7(1)(c)	In any way mark or paint any tree growing in a public road or attach any advertisement thereto	R300

GOOS, BUILDING MATERIALS, MOTOR VEHICLE WRECKS, DANGEROUS OBJECTS

Sect 8(a)(i)	Leave, store, pack or unpack goods or cause or permit goods to be left, stored, packed or unpacked, or accumulate or cause to be accumulated in any public place or balcony or verandah erected beyond the boundary of a public road any building materials, motor vehicle wrecks, spare parts of vehicles, building, waste materials or scaffolding	R500 for first offence and no fine for further offences
Sect 8(a)(ii)	Bore or cut stone, slake or sift lime, or mix building materials in any public place	R500 for first offence and no fine for further offences
Sect 8(b)	Leave or accumulate or cause to be left or accumulated in any public place, or permit to be placed in any public place from premises owned or occupied by him or her, any broken glass or other potentially dangerous object	R500 for first offence and no fine for further offences
Sect 8(c)	Transport or cause or permit to be transported building materials, mixed or unmixed, on a public road in such a way as to damage the road	R500 for first offence and no fine for further offences

EXCAVATIONS IN STREETS

Sect 9(1)(a)	Make or cause to be made an excavation or dig or cause to be dug a pit, trench or hole a public road without the City's written permission	R500
Sect 9(1)(b)	Make or cause to be made an excavation or dig or cause to be dug a pit, trench or hole in a public road, otherwise than in accordance with requirements prescribed by the City	R500

POISON IN STREETS AND CONVEYANCE OF ANIMAL CARCASSES AND OTHER WASE

Sect 10(1)	Set or cast poison in public roads (City officials or authorised persons who administer legally approved weed-killers or poisons excluded)	No Admission of Guilt Fine
Sect 10(2)(a)	Carry or convey through public road the carcass of an animal or any garbage, nightsoil, refuse, litter, rubbish or manure which isn't properly covered	R500
Section 10(2)(b)	Carry or convey through a public road the carcass of an animal or any garbage, nightsoil, refuse, litter, rubbish or manure which isn't conveyed in a container which will not allow any offensive liquids or parts of the load to be spilt in the road	R500

PROCESSIONS

Sect 11(1)(a)	Hold, organise, initiate, control or actively participate in a procession, demonstration or gathering in a public place	No Admission of Guilt Fine
Sect 11(1)(b)	Dance or sing or play a musical instrument in a public place	R50
Sect 11(1)(c)	Do anything which is likely to cause a gathering of persons or the disruption or obstruction of traffic in a public place	R200
Sect 11(1)(d)	Use any loudspeaker or other device for the reproduction or amplification of sound	R500

PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN ACTIVITIES IN CONNECTION WITH OBJECTS

Sect 12(a)	Wash, clean or dry any object, including any clothing, in a public place, including on a balcony or verandah erected beyond the boundary line of a public road	R50
Sect 12(b)	Repair a vehicle in a public place, except where necessary for the purpose of removing such vehicle from the place where it was involved in an accident or has a breakdown	R400

DRYING OF WASHING ON FENCES ON BOUNDARIES

Sect 13	Dry or spread washing in a public place or on a fence on the boundary of a public road	R50

PROHIBITION UPON SKATING, ROLLERSKATING AND DANGEROUS ACTS

Sect 14(a)	Skate on roller skates or a skateboard or similar device on a public road where prohibited by the City	R200

Sect 14(b)	Do anything in a public place which may endanger the life or safety of any person or animal	No Admission of Guilt Fine
Sect 14(b)(i)	Shoot with a bow and arrow or catapult, or throw a stone, stick or other projectile in, onto or across a public road	No Admission of Guilt Fine
Sect 14(b)(ii)	Use explosives or discharge fireworks, without permission or otherwise than in accordance with conditions determined by the City when granting permission	No Admission of Guilt Fine
Sect 14(b)(iii)	Discharge any firearm or air, gas or alarm gun or pistol	No Admission of Guilt Fine

CONTROL OF GOODS OFFERED FOR SALE

Sect 15	Display or offer for sale any goods or produce in a public place without permission	R200

BRIDGES AND CROSSINGS OVER GUTTERS AND SIDEWALKS

Sect 16	Make or build private crossings, pathway, bridge or culvert to or in front of any dwelling or other premises in any public place without permission	R500

CONTROL OF AMUSEMENT SHOWS AND DEVICES

Sect 17(1)	Set up or use in any public place any circus, whirligig, roundabout or other side show or device for the amusement or recreation of the public without permission, otherwise than in accordance with such conditions as may be determined by the City, unless suitable sanitary conveniences for both sexes of the staff and public have been provided there and if it is in any way dangerous or unsafe for public use	R500

SLEEPING OR RESIDING IN VEHICLES PROHIBITED

Sect 18 (a)	Sleep or reside in a vehicle in a public place except in dire emergency	R200 for first offence
Sect 18 (b)	Reside in a vehicle for longer than twenty four hours	R200 for first offence

DISPLAY OF STREET NUMBERS

Sect 19 (2)	Fail to comply with direction in terms of a notice from the City regarding display of street number and replacing or repainting any digit of such number which has become illegible, obliterated or defaced	R100

MOTOR VEHICLE AND BOAT BUILDING AND REPAIRS

Sect 20 (a)	Build, dismantle, re-assemble, repair or adjust any motor vehicle or any boat on any premises which is not duly registered and licensed for that purpose unless the motor vehicle or boat is owned by a person resident on the premises and such work is carried out by a person so resident or the City has granted permission	R400 for first offence and no fine for further offences
Sect 20 (b)	Build, dismantle, re-assemble, repair or adjust any motor	R400 for first

	vehicle or boat in contravention of any condition imposed by the City when granting permission	offence and no fine for further offences
Sect 20 (c)	Build, dismantle, repair or adjust any motor vehicle or any boat earlier than 07h00 or later than 20h00	R400 for first offence and no fine for further offences
Sect 20 (d)	Fail to comply with notice to cease work on any motor vehicle or boat	R400 for first offence and no fine for further offences

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH NOTICE

Sect 22 (2)	Fail to comply with notice to terminate contravention of any provision of this by-law, or to remove the structure, object, material or substance, or to take such other steps as the City may require to rectify such contravention within the period stated in the notice	R1000
